Skill Tests: Snowplow Sam Levels 1, 2, 3, 4 & Basic 1 Tots

Little Stars skaters develop preliminary coordination and strength to move around on the ice. The introductory classes are divided into four progressive levels for kids with no prior skating experience to build confidence in skating and themselves. Learning skating skills through fun and games makes this positive experience for your kids enjoyable and memorable.

Program includes a weekly 30-minute instructional class and public skating session. Little Stars who complete the Snowplow Sam Levels 1, 2, 3, 4 & Basic 1 Tots will transition into the Level 1 Learn to Skate program.

REGISTRATION

Class size is limited, and enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. **Classes fill up quickly, skaters are encouraged to register early for classes.** Provided space is available, a skater may register at anytime throughout the session; class fee will be pro-rated. **Students must attend the same class day and time throughout the program series.** Students registering seven days before the first day

of class receive a \$10 discount. Additional family members enrolled in the same program series receive a 10 percent discount. Registration for classes may be done online at www.rmuislandsports.org, in person at the Customer Service desk or you may call: 412-397-4454 and you will be connected to the customer service desk where you may register over the phone with a credit card. Full payment is due at the time of registration.

LEARN TO SKATE AGES 6-ADULT

Basic Skills teaches the FUNdamentals of ice skating and provides the best foundation for figure skating, hockey or recreational skating. Six progressive levels introduce forward and backward skating, stops, edges, crossovers and turns. Upon completion of the Basic Skills 1-6 levels, skaters will be able to confidently advance to more specialized areas of skating. All classes will be well structured with the focus on proper skill development taught in a positive, FUN and social environment. Skaters will progress at their own rate and advance after skill mastery is demonstrated. No experience is necessary.

The classes are divided into Level 1 & Level 2 based on Skill Tests:

Level 1: Basic Skills Tests 1, 2, 3, 4

Level 2: Basic Skills Tests 5 & 6

Level 1 (Basic 1, 2, 3, 4)

Level 1 includes skaters with no formal instructional experience or with experience at the Basic 1, 2, 3 or 4 skill tests. Class includes a weekly 30-minute instructional class, skate rental, if necessary, and a public skating session.

Level 2 (Basic 5 & 6)

Level 2 includes skaters who have passed the Level 1 Skill Tests: Basic 1, 2, 3 & 4 and are at the Basic Skills 5 or 6 skill levels. Class includes a weekly 40-minute instructional class (10 minutes of stroking workshop and 30 minutes of skill-focused instruction), skate rental, if necessary, and a public skating session. **Skaters entering Level 2 should have their own ice skates.** Please see our Pro Shop for details and information about our quality ice skates.
